## **Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation**

CAC is proud to announce the official launch of the online evaluation software for the Make Ethical Decisions (MED) outcome of the new NCCP. All coaches and Learning Facilitators (LFs) who currently possess a CC # are strongly encouraged to complete the online evaluation and to encourage all coaches to complete it once they finish the training in the MED module or have accessed the Pre-evaluation demo and are confident that their previous knowledge and experience will enable them to complete the evaluation successfully.

### **Before you start the evaluation, you will need:**

- Your CC #. If you do not know your CC #, please contact the NCCP Database via e-mail at [coach@coach.ca](mailto:coach@coach.ca). Include your full name, date of birth, mailing address, and e-mail address in the correspondence.
- An account with the NCCP Database. If you have your CC #, but do not have an account set up for the NCCP Database, visit <http://nccpdb.coach.ca/production/>, click on "Sign Me Up", and follow the instructions. If you encounter any problems signing up, contact the NCCP Database via e-mail at [coach@coach.ca](mailto:coach@coach.ca). Remember to include your full name, CC #, and e-mail address in the correspondence.
- For those coaches taking their first NCCP course you will not have a CC # until you are entered into the NCCP database. Depending on the volume of entries this can take up to four weeks. You cannot log in to the Making Ethical Decisions online evaluation without a CC # so please be patient.
- The Coaches Association of Saskatchewan (CAS) office can check NCCP database records online so if urgent you can contact CAS to check for your CC # as your online record will appear sooner than getting your CC # through the mail. ### **Please be advised:**

- The evaluation can take at least one hour to complete. You may quit the application in order to continue when it's more convenient without losing your place.
- The application only allows two attempts at successfully completing the evaluation. If both attempts are unsuccessful, you will be required to participate in an MED module in order to access the online evaluation for another two attempts.
- Once you have successfully completed the online evaluation, your file on the NCCP Database will be automatically updated. To view your transcript online, visit <http://nccpdb.coach.ca/production/> and login using the same username and password you used to access the online evaluation.

This is the first phase of the online evaluation software for MED. Sports are encouraged to discuss development of sport-specific scenarios for integration into the evaluation with their CAC Consultant. The next phase of development includes the development of the software for Community Sport and the Competition – Development contexts.
