

**Northern Art Show & Sale**  
Part of the Northern Saskatchewan Sport & Cultural Festival  
October 13-15, 2009

The Northern Art Show and Sale was run as part of the Northern Saskatchewan Sport and Cultural Festival in Beauval, by the La Ronge Arts Council and the Northern Sport Culture and Recreation District (NSCRD).

Thirteen artists participated in the exhibition. Their work was varied and included Traditional Bead work , Antler Carving, Photography, Linocut Printing and Painting ranging from Abstract through First Nation to Figurative styles.

The adjudicator appraised all the works and gave critiques to the artists present which they seemed to enjoy. He also ran a work shop on Abstract painting in which the participants produce their own piece of Abstract art work. His final function was to select artists to receive prizes.

1st Prize went to Roger Jerome of Air Ronge

2<sup>nd</sup> to Frankie McIntyre of Beauval

3<sup>rd</sup> to Allen Morrow Air Ronge.

Honorable Mention was given to Cameron McIntosh, La Ronge. Miriam Körner, Potato Lake and Celeste Miller, Napatak.

Recommendations to the Organization of Saskatchewan Arts Councils (OSAC) for submission of proposals:

Visitors were asked to vote for the artist of their choice. All artists received a vote and the most popular was Frankie McIntyre.

The show was visited by more than 200 people (54 left comments in the guest book) many of whom expressed their appreciation of the art work and the effort that went into producing the show. Visitors came from 17 different Saskatchewan communities and also from Alberta, Manitoba and Ontario.
