



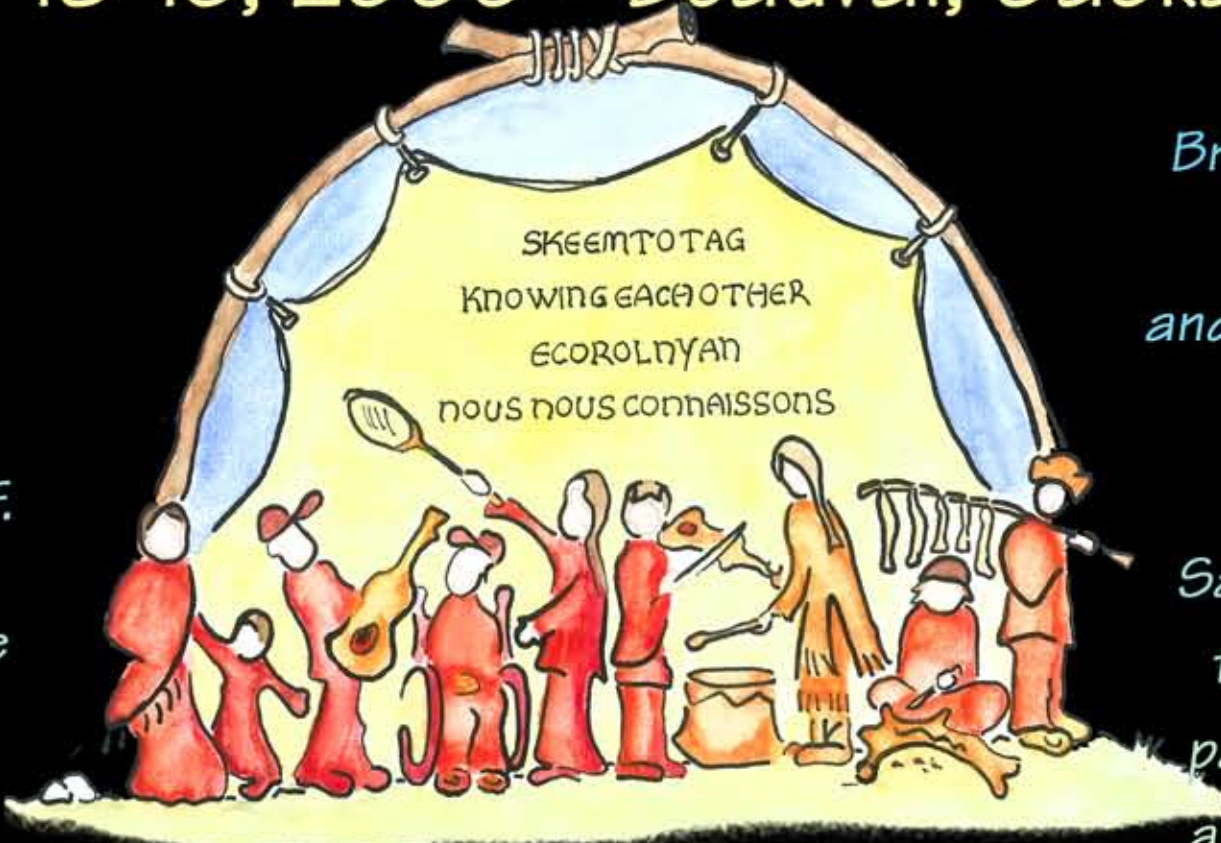
Northern Saskatchewan Sport and Culture Festival

Program Information

Purpose of the Northern Saskatchewan Sport & Cultural Festival

The **purpose** of the Northern Saskatchewan Sport & Cultural Festival is to bring youth, families, and communities from Northern Saskatchewan together to participate in and celebrate traditional and contemporary cultural activities, athlete and coach sport development.

Program Outcomes

- ❖ People from across northern Saskatchewan come together to get to know each other and for northern cultural exchange
- ❖ A northern community experiences and benefits from hosting the Northern Saskatchewan Sport & Cultural Festival
- ❖ Artists and craftspeople have inspired interest in contemporary cultural activities
- ❖ Traditional culture and skills are experienced and celebrated
- ❖ Athlete and coach sport development opportunities are provided that can contribute to the success of community sport programs and Sport Programs' participation

The theme of the NSSCF is "Knowing Each Other"

Target Groups

Primary Target Group – Participants

- ❖ Youth aged 12-19 (or older as long as they are still in secondary/high school)
- ❖ Coaches
- ❖ Chaperones
- ❖ **Total Participants – 270 – split as evenly as possible between males and females, 150 in cultural workshops, 120 in sport workshops**

Others/Other Components:

- ❖ Northern Art Show & Sale
- ❖ Workshop for people with special needs (Oct.14 – 1 day)
- ❖ Northern artists, elders as resources/leaders
- ❖ Staff, Volunteers, Other Resource Leaders
- ❖ Visitors

Application Process

Youth and adults (chaperones or coaches) must submit an application by September 15, 2009. Selections will be made and participants notified in September.

Participant Travel, Accommodations, and Meals

Participant meals and accommodation will be provided at Valley View School in Beauval. Communities (participants) travel will be supported by the Northern Sport, Culture and Recreation District, utilizing community buses, vans or personal vehicles. This will be coordinated through the NSCRD upon selection of the participants. Travel (described below), meals and accommodations are all provided through the NSCRD.

Format – 3 day Festival

The Festival is over three days. The morning of the first day and afternoon of the third day are travel times. There are two types of youth participants – culture or sport. Adults are involved as chaperones or in coaching clinics.

During the day, youth participants will be involved in the sport or cultural workshops. The culture participants will rotate through a series of traditional workshop s and one contemporary workshop. The sport participants will participate in a youth athlete development workshop and the coaches in a coaching clinic in one of two sports – wrestling or badminton.

The evening activities will include entertainment and dances for all participants.
