



## Northern Drama Project



The NSCRD is partnering with the Saskatchewan Drama Association (SDA) and four northern communities on a drama development project. Congratulations to Valley View School in Beauval (Leader Cynthia Scratch), Rossignol High School in Ile a la Crosse (Leader Alice Ratt), Charlebois Community School in Cumberland House (Leader Lana Patterson), and Senator Allan Bird Memorial School in Montreal Lake (Leader Sandy Brant).

This project has received funding support through grants from the Government of Saskatchewan Prevention & Support Program and the SaskCulture Capacity Building Grant.

In brief, this drama development project involves the following components to help communities to develop a drama program in their community and be part of a northern drama festival.

1. Help to Get Started - Lenore Bailey, Sask Drama Association Project Manager for this project and Roy Challis, mentor for this project will assist each community to get their program started.
2. One Day Workshop in each community – to be held by Feb.5, 2009, lead by Roy Challis.
3. Development, Keeping Things Going - Lenore and Roy will provide distance support the communities to keep the momentum and development going.
4. One Day Workshop in each community – to be held by March 21, 2009, lead by Roy Challis.
5. Festival Preparation - Lenore and Roy will provide distance support the communities to prepare for the Northern Mini Drama Festival (or Region 12 Drama Festival).
6. Northern Mini Drama Festival on April 2-4, 2009. Location to be determined.
7. The winning production from the Northern Mini Drama Festival will be selected to compete or showcase at the SDA Provincial Drama Festival in Regina from May 7-9, 2009.
