  - Use Quest Quality measurement tools for observing and evaluating children's experiences in programs.
  - Acknowledge the crucial role of supervisors in setting the tone for healthy child development in an organization.
- To share summer sport, culture and recreation program plans and information.
- To support networking among Northern Community & School Recreation Coordinators (CSRCs).
- To provide CSRCs with an opportunity to provide feedback and input into the evolution of the NC&SRC Program.
