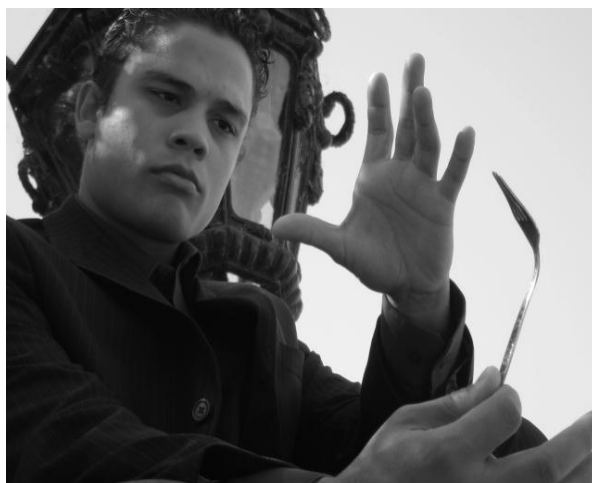
- **One additional vehicle** will be reimbursed from each site.

- Participants will be responsible for their own meals. The training event will provide 2 breakfasts, 1 lunch and 1 supper.
