





RACE NOTICE Sask. Cup #8 & School Ski Championships

DON ALLEN TRAILS, LA RONGE

FRIDAY, MARCH 17, 2023

REGISTRATION MUST BE DONE ONLINE BY 7pm ON WEDNESDAY, MARCH 15, 2023, AT https://zone4.ca/event/2023/WzqKba/

Skill Required: The Don Allen Trails have challenging terrain, therefore skiers should have the ability to climb the up hills and snowplow and slow down on the down hills if required.

Note: The School Ski Championships event focuses on school ski groups. However, the Championship is a Sask Cup event, and it is open to entries from ALL skiers regardless of age. The event will accept entries from individuals who are not part of a school ski group, and those individuals will be able to earn Sask Cup points if they are registered with an affiliated CCS ski club.

<u>Late Registrations</u>: Late registrations may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Organizing Committee. Any late registrations accepted will pay an additional late fee of \$10 per race.

COMPETITIONS

<u>The main event is a free technique distance race</u> with mass starts. Racers are to be at the race venue on Friday by 10:00 a.m. to be ready for the race start at 11:00 a.m. Race office opens at 9:30 a.m. at the Don Allen Trails and will remain open until the day's official results are posted.

Relay Event

In the <u>Junior</u> Relay, schools are invited to field a team of 4 skiers who will each ski a 300-metre loop. A Junior Relay Team must consist of 2 girls and 2 boys from the <u>same</u> school <u>in the U12</u> <u>category or younger</u>.

In the <u>Open</u> Relay, schools are invited to field a team of 4 skiers who will each ski a 460-metre loop. An Open Team must consist of 2 girls and 2 boys from the <u>same</u> school. Skiers can be from <u>any</u> age class. Schools will be allowed to enter more than one team.

Cash Sprints: There will be fun, short distance cash sprints held in the stadium just prior to the awards ceremony for racers under the age of 18. \$10.00 for 1st and \$5.00 for 2nd. A good chance to win some cash!

VENUE: Don Allen Ski Trail system, located 20 km north of La Ronge on Highway

102 at the junction of Highway 102 & the Nemeiben Lake Road.

RULES: Cross Country Saskatchewan Sask Cup Series Rules (2022-23 version); and FIS ICR - CCR (Canadian Competition Rules) November Precisions 2021. Para Nordic categories will also be governed by Para Nordic International Competition Rules (ICR), October 2022.

CANCELLATION: In the event that weather or trail conditions require cancellation of the race(s), the Race Committee will notify Cross Country Saskatchewan by 12PM on Wednesday, March 15 if the race(s) must be cancelled.

Races must be cancelled, delayed, or postponed if the temperature on the coldest part of the course is below -20° C. U12 - U8 categories must be cancelled, delayed, or postponed if the temperature on the coldest part of the course is below -15°C.

The Race Committee also reserves the right to modify race format, distances and start times before or on race day due to weather or trail conditions.

Unofficial Results and Protests: Unofficial results will be posted at the race office. The time of posting will be marked on the unofficial results. Any protests must be made to the Competition Secretary within 15 minutes of the unofficial results being posted, after which the results will be declared official.

Awards

Ribbons: Ribbons for 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be awarded to racers in all categories at the race stadium at the close of the races.

Banners: Gold banners will be awarded to the top schools in both a "large school" and a "small school" category based on participation points and other considerations. Banners will also be awarded to schools winning the Junior Relay and Open Relay.

Wax Policy




