Program Description:

Making Ethical Decisions (MED) is a required module for all Canoe-Kayak Coaching Contexts.

To be "trained/certified" as CanoeKids, you **MUST** take the MED course and the online exam.

The MED course is offered through the Coaching Association of Saskatchewan <https://saskcoach.ca/upcoming-events/> and is offered in the Spring and the Fall. The cost is typically \$45 or \$50 for the course.

CANOE KAYAK SASKATCHEWAN will be providing 2 FREE opportunities for CKS Club coaches to take the MED course this year. Other individuals are more than welcome to register, the cost is \$30/individual.
